**ORDINANCE 17-2517 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 344 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD, ENTITLED "SANITARY CODE"**

was introduced at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Thursday, November 9, 2017 and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the Executive Chambers, Bergenfield Municipal Center, 198 North Washington Avenue, Bergenfield, New Jersey on Tuesday, December 5, 2017 at 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement is to amend 344-53 to change subsection 3 to four pieces of household items and subsection 4 to two major household appliances as set forth in the ordinance.

**Ordinance No. 17-2517**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 344 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD,  
ENTITLED "SANITARY CODE"**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 344 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding the Sanitary Code within the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

Chapter 344-53 entitled Maximum allowable bulk refuse by type

A. The maximum allowable bulk refuse allowed quarterly per household/unit is:

(3) Four pieces of household furniture.

(4) Two major household appliances such as washers, dryers or refrigerators

Severability All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
