**ORDINANCE 18-2522 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 136 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD ENTITLED “CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM”**

was introduced at a work session meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the Council Chambers, Bergenfield Municipal Center, 198 North Washington Avenue, Bergenfield, New Jersey on Tuesday, March 20, 2018 at 8:00 p.m. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement is to amend the fees in Chapter 136-4 under Article 1 entitled “Enforcement” as set forth in the ordinance.

**Ordinance No. 18-2522**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 136 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BERGENFIELD,  
ENTITLED "CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM"**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 136 of the Code of the Borough of Bergenfield sets forth all regulations regarding Construction Codes, Uniform within the Borough of Bergenfield; and,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that those portions of the aforesaid set forth below are hereby amended as follows and that those portions of the Ordinance not set forth below shall remain unchanged.

Article I entitled Enforcement.

Chapter 136-4 Fees.

Paragraph F. Elevator safety subcode:

(1) Witnessing acceptance tests and performing inspections:

(a) Elevator devices in structures not in Use Group R-3 or R-4:

i. Traction and winding drum elevators:

(a) One to 10 floors \$340.00

(b) Over 10 floors \$567.00

ii. Hydraulic elevators \$302.00

iii. Roped hydraulic elevators \$340.00

iv. Escalators, moving walks \$302.00

v. Dumbwaiters \$ 76.00

vi. Stairway chairlifts, inclined and vertical \$ 76.00

wheelchair lifts and manlifts

(b) Additional charges for devices equipped with the following features:

i. Oil buffers (charge per oil buffer) \$ 60.00

ii. Counterweight governor and safeties \$151.00

iii. Auxiliary power generator \$114.00

(c) Elevator devices in structures in Use Groups R-3 and R-4: \$227.00.

(d) Witnessing acceptance tests of, and performing inspections of, alterations: \$ 76.00.

(2) Routine and periodic tests and inspections for elevator devices in structures not in Use Groups R-3 and R-4:

(a) Six month routine inspection:

(i) Traction and winding drum elevators;

(a) One to 10 floors: \$340.00

(b) Over 10 floors: \$567.00

(ii) Hydraulic elevators: \$302.00

(iii) Roped hydraulic elevators: \$340.00

(iv) Escalators, moving walks: \$302.00

(b) One-year periodic inspection and witnessing of tests of elevator devices:

(i) Traction and winding drum elevators:

(a) One to 10 floors: \$ 400.00

(b) Over 10 floors: \$ 450.00

(ii) Hydraulic elevators: \$ 350.00

(iii) Roped Hydraulic Elevators: \$ 375.00

(iv) Escalators, moving walks: \$695.00

(v) Dumbwaiters: \$120.00

(vi) Manlifts, stairway chairlifts, inclined and vertical  
wheelchair lifts: \$182.00

(c) One-year periodic inspection charges for elevator devices equipped with the following features:

(i) Oil buffers (per oil buffer): \$60.00

(ii) Counterweight governor and safeties: \$120.00

(iii) Auxiliary power generator: \$76.00

(d) Three or five year inspection:

(i) One to 10 floors (five year inspection): \$513.00

(ii) Over 10 floors (five year inspection): \$646.00

(e) The fee for any reinspection of elevator device shall be set at \$100.00 and shall be billed separately from the above upon issuance of a notice of violation necessitating a reinspection.

Severability All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.
